

## Descendants of Frederick Joyner Sr.

Frederick Joyner was born before 1755 (1). He lived in Lancaster County and probably died between 1810 and 1820 (1). Based on his son's real estate settlement, we know that he had nine children. Record of the Court of Common Pleas, Lancaster County, Box 7, No. 1331 from November 15, 1828, state that the executors of Frederick Joyner were Daniel Joyner, Frederick Joyner and Middleton Joyner. It appears Frederick was closely connected to the Cornelius, House, and McDonald families. According to a Lancaster County deed from April 22, 1789, John Cornelius was married to Charity Joiner in March of 1776 by Rev. Thomas Stringer (or Stinger) of the Church of England. They had a son named Roger Cornelius (18). This Charity may have been a sister or niece of Frederick. In 1804, John and Thomas House brought suit against the minor heirs of John Cornelius. Witnesses in the case included Rebecca Wallace and Ruth Joiner, and one of the witnesses for the Cornelius children was Frederick Joiner (19). The Cornelius family were some of the earliest of the Camp Creek settlers. The guardian of the Cornelius children was a George Wade (Jr.). The wife of George Wade Sr. was a Sarah McDonald (b. 1772), daughter of a Middleton McDonald and Elizabeth Reeves. This is interesting, given that one of Frederick's children was named Middleton. Jeremiah Joyner, who appears on the 1790 census in Lancaster District may have been a brother to Frederick.

+ Ruth. She was named in Frederick's will from 1818 contained in the Equity Court case from 1825 (75).

Age order of children is a guess based off of census records and the order of the list of defendants in the real estate case for estate of Frederick Jr.

Other grandchildren of Frederick Joyner, Sr., not listed are Sarah (Joyner) who married Evan Deas, George Joyner, and Elizabeth (Joyner) who married a Mr. Turner. These are listed in the 1849 announcement for the Frederick Jr. real estate settlement and are children of either Middleton or John.

1. Rutha Joyner. Rutha Barrett was named as a child in the Lancaster County Returns book for the account of Frederick Jr's estate in 1849. Mrs. Barrett may have been the first child, going off the census and order of the grandchildren listed in the 1849 announcement for the Frederick Jr. real estate settlement. Rutha Barrett was living in Lancaster County in 1830 but had moved to Covington Co., AL, by 1840. She was living near her son Joyner and a Prestly Barrett. "Prestly" may be a mistaken entry for Wesley, or this could be another brother who died before 1850. It appears the children in that household were probably living with Wesley in 1850. Rutha died between 1840 and 1850. Her two living daughters, Sarah and Emily, moved to Tennessee by 1843 and Joyner followed, moving sometime between 1847 and 1860. Rutha almost certainly was the wife of William Barrett who appears living next to Frederick Joiner Sr. in the 1800 census. The census shows that one of Frederick's daughters had moved out by that time. Census records also show that she was born about 1774-1775 and died between 1840 and

1850. She lived in the Rose Hill area of Covington Co., Alabama, and may have died there.

In 1849, six of her children were still living. Joyner directly received share as noted in the receipt book and was therefore an heir. Newton had power of Attorney for Joyner. He and his brother Jasper were both living in South Carolina which is why they did not appear in the newspaper announcement. Wesley Barrett and Joyner Barrett appear together in the newspaper announcement list for the real estate of Frederick Jr. from 1849. Next in the list are two females, Emily Auten and Sarah C. Hendrick (Kendrick). Sarah C. Barrett was listed along with Welsey, Joyner, and Martha Barrett (Joyner or Wesley's wife) as a customer of the Parker store in Covington Co., AL, around the 1830s. Emily Auten is next on the list from the 1849 newspaper announcement, and she was living next to Sarah Kendrick in 1850, so she must have been a Barrett as well. That completes the list of the six children living in 1849/50. Based on early census records, Rutha appears to have had a daughter born 1800-1810 who had died by then and also probably two other sons who had died as well.

+ Probably William Barrett. Born about 1755-1774 in North Carolina (1). The post 1870 censuses for both Wesley and Jasper all state that the father was born in North Carolina and the mother in South Carolina. He was probably from Mecklenburg County or Anson County. The family cemetery where Newton and Jasper were buried is directly below Monroe which is about where the line between the two counties was before Union County was formed from them in 1842. There were no other Barretts in Lancaster County in the early 1800s census records besides William and Rutha. If Rutha was on the census in the Joyner household in 1790, then they would have married between 1790 and 1800. William and Rutha probably married around 1790 as it appears the older Barretts were likely born closer to 1790-91. William appears to have died between 1820 and 1830.

A. Joyner D. Barrett was born about 1790-1800 in South Carolina (1)(3). He lived in Covington Co., AL, in 1830 and 1840, but had moved to Stewart Co., TN, by 1860. Listed as D. Joyner Barrett on the customer list of the Parker's store in Covington County which was in business in the 1830's (72). A Daniel Barrett was also listed. This is probably the middle name of Joyner or Newton. Probably died between 1860 and 1870.

+ Martha. Born about 1812 in Georgia (3).

i. Jasper A. Barrett. Born about 1830 in Alabama (3). He was a Corporal and Private in Company I of the 50th Regiment, Tennessee Infantry from Dover in Stewart County in the Civil War. Died May 26, 1862 at Camp Douglas. One of 6,000 Confederate soldiers who died as Prisoners of War at Camp Douglas in Chicago and were buried in Oak Woods Cemetery, Chicago, Cook Co., Illinois.

ii. Newton Barrett. Born about 1832 in Alabama (3).

iii. Ruth(a) Barrett. Born about 1839 in Alabama (3). Listed in index to Indian Wars pensions from April 1894 as widow for Alfred.

+ Alfred Alley. Married December 27, 1860 in Stewart Co., TN (6). Born about 1810-1816 (4)(5).

a. David Alley. Born January 20, 1863 (4)(10). Died October 23, 1931 in Humphreys Co., TN (10). Buried in the Lewis Cemetery, Humphreys Co., TN (10).

b. Joseph William Alley. Born April 19, 1864 in Houston Co., TN (4)(10). Died September 29, 1916 in Canalou, New Madrid Co., MO (10). Buried in Big Bridge Cemetery (10).

+ Dora Deek. Married about 1892 (13). Born about 1866 in Tennessee (30).

+ Sarah Jane Bearden. Born March 22, 1865 in Elkton, Kentucky (10)(13). Died August 9, 1940 in Parma, New Madrid Co., MO (10). Buried in Malden Cemetery (10).

1. Alfred Alley. Born April 1897 in Kentucky (13).

2. Calvin Alley. Born September 1899 in Kentucky (13).

d. Jeannette Alley. Born about 1869 (4).

e. ? Eudora Alley. Born about 1873 (5).

iv. Martha Barrett. Born about 1840 in Alabama (3). Might have married John Alley. John and Martha are listed next to Ruth Alley in 1880 census.

v. Theodore Barrett. Born about 1845 in Alabama (3).

vi. Ueustus/Eustice Barrett. Born about 1847 in Alabama (3).

B. Wesley Barrett. Born about 1794-1807 in South Carolina (2)(4)(5)(7). Although the census records state he was born in South Carolina, his son William's death certificate states that he was born in Union Co., NC, which hints towards a connection to the Union County Barretts. His headstone says he was born 1794 and the 1850 record agrees, but later census records point to about 1807. Apparently lived in Covington Co., AL, along with the other Barretts for a time. He is listed as a customer of the James B. Parker's store in Cauleysville in the Rose Hill area of Covington Co., AL (72). He also appears to have had a couple transactions with a blacksmith in Lancaster County in 1834 (67). He might have had two families, one in Alabama and another once he moved back to South Carolina. Must have moved between 1850 and 1870. He lived for a while in Kershaw County but lived the later part of his life in the Flat Creek area of Lancaster County (4)(5). Died June 18, 1881 and was buried in the Gregory Cemetery in Lancaster Co., SC (7). Although some histories report that he was buried in the Riley Catoe Cemetery, otherwise known as the Catoe-Kennington-McManus Cemetery, his headstone stands in the Gregory Cemetery.

He appears in 1850 in Alabama living with a Martha, born about 1785 in North Carolina, and three children, William age 18, born in North Carolina, Thomas age 15, born in South Carolina, and Frances age 12, born in South Carolina. Given the age difference between him and Martha, I can't but wonder if this was a deceased sibling or relative's family. Also, based on the list of customers of the store in Covington in the 1830s, Wesley was there during that time, but these Barretts were born in North Carolina and South Carolina during that same time. There is a Prestly Barrett living near the Barretts in 1840. The ages of the children match the ones living with Wesley in 1850, so this is either Wesley or a brother who died between 1840 and 1850.

+ Jane Starnes. She may have married twice as one or two records say she was a Ghent. She was born about 1835-1840 in South Carolina or North Carolina (4)(5). Died 1900-1910.

i. Eliza Barrett. Born about 1862 in Lancaster Co., SC (4)(5). Her death certificate says she was born July 8, 1871 in Lancaster County Her headstone says 1871 as well, but the census makes it clear she was born about 1862. The 1930 census says she was divorced. Everything else including death certificate says widowed. The 1920 says widowed. The

1910 says widowed. Died April 7, 1949 in Lancaster Co., SC (10). Buried in Taxahaw Baptist Church, Lancaster Co., SC.

+ Pinkney Butler Starnes. Born August 5, 1854 (7). Died April 24, 1938 (7). Buried in Prospect United Methodist Church Cemetery, Union Co., NC.

a. Ernest Starnes. Born May 23, 1881 in Union Co., NC (10). 1900 census says he was born July 1882. Died September 4, 1955 in Lancaster Co., SC (10). Buried in Taxahaw Baptist Church, Lancaster Co., SC.

+ Mattie Hagins.

b. Mattie Starnes. Born about April 1883 in South Carolina (13).

c. Sarah Starnes. Born about January 1885 in South Carolina (13).

d. Dick Starnes. Born about August 1886 in South Carolina (13).

e. Charley O. Starnes. Born about May 1888 in South Carolina (13). Death certificate says he was born January 10, 1890 in Union Co., NC. Died July 23, 1950 in Kershaw Co., SC (10). Buried in Taxahaw Baptist Church Cemetery, Lancaster Co., SC.

f. Judge Butler Starnes. Born December 12, 1894 in South Carolina (10). Died February 14, 1975 in Huntersville, Mecklenburg Co., NC (10). Buried in Kannapolis Cemetery, Cabarrus Co., NC.

+ Ollie Belle Mundy. Born March 2, 1896 (7). Died December 4, 1920 (7). Buried in Kannapolis Cemetery, Cabarrus Co., NC.

+ Ada E. Causey. Born May 14, 1889 (7). Died December 2, 1948 (7). Buried in Kannapolis Cemetery, Cabarrus Co., NC.

g. Sis Starnes. Born about January 1892 in South Carolina (13)(30).

h. Dee Starnes. Born about February 1894 in South Carolina (13).

i. Lizzie Starnes. Born about March 1897 in South Carolina (13).

j. Mitchel Starnes. Born November 1, 1900 in South Carolina (7)(10)(30). Died December 25, 1973 in Morganton, Burke Co., NC (7)(10). Buried in the Bowman-Rector Cemetery.

+ McManus.

ii. Sanford A. Barrett. Born about 1865 in South Carolina (4)(5). Sanford had several run ins with the law. He was a moonshiner, and when the constables came to arrest him, he and his companions fired at them. Sanford was wounded and died days later in the Camden Hospital (62). Died July 19, 1919 in Camden, Kershaw Co., SC (10). Buried in Wateree Mill Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

+ Frances Boone. She was the daughter of John Boone, long time Camden jailor, and his wife Frances (62). Married about 1887 (13). Born April 1872 in South Carolina (13).

a. John Barrett. Born June 1888 in South Carolina (13)(30)(51).

h. Martha Barrett. Born about 1901 in South Carolina (30)(51). Died October 31, 1929 in Camden, Kershaw Co., SC (10). Buried in Beaverdam Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

i. William Barrett. Born March 18, 1902 in South Carolina

(7)(30)(51). Died March 29, 1966 (7). Buried in Beaverdam Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

+ Mary Roberts.

j. Hazel Barrett. Born April 6, 1905 in Kershaw Co., SC (10)(30)(51). Died November 12, 1938 in Flat Rock, Kershaw Co., SC (10). Buried in Beaverdam Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

+ Allie.

iii. Frances Elizabeth Barrett. Born about 1866 in South Carolina (4)(5). This may have been Lou, daughter of Wesley, who married a Mrs. Deas and later took up with a Mr. Aaron Boone (62). Lou had a son named Steward Wesley Barrett. They lived in Flat Rock and Buffalo in the early 1900s.

a. Steward Wesley Barrett. Born May 2, 1882 in Lancaster Co., SC (10). Died November 19, 1945 in Lancaster, SC (10). Buried in West Side Cemetery, Lancaster Co., SC (10).

+ Married his first cousin, Bertha Starnes, daughter of Eliza and Butler Starnes.

iv. Barbara Almetta Barrett. Born about April 16, 1867-1869 in South Carolina (4)(5)(10). Death certificate says 1867. Census indicates 1869. Died January 15, 1961 in Kershaw Co., SC (10). Buried in Providence Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

+ James Marion Shehorne. Married about 1883-1886 (13)(22)(30). Born about 1865 (22)(30). Jim was known as a faith doctor and had many people visit him and claim that they had been healed.

a. Sidney Shehorne. Born about January 1888 in South Carolina (13)(30). Death Certificate says February 27, 1884 in Kershaw Co., SC (10). Died October 22, 1951 in Columbia, SC (10). Buried in Providence Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC (10).

b. Daisy Louisa Shehorne. Born about May 1890 in South Carolina (13)(30).

e. Lonnie Shehorne. Born about July 1897 in South Carolina (13)(22)(30). Later census records give approximate birth year as 1902.

f. Vernon Randolph (James Lee) Shehorne. Born about May 5, 1906 in South Carolina (7)(10)(30). Headstone says May 6. Died May 28, 1954 in Lancaster Co., SC (7)(10). Buried in Providence Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC (10).

+ Willie Mae Watford. Born July 28, 1910 (7). Died April 14, 1989 (7). Buried in Providence Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

g. Netta Shehorne. Born about 1905 in South Carolina (30). Funeral Home marker says 1908. Died 1985 (7). Buried in Providence Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

v. James Wesley Barrett. Born about March 18, 1871 or 1872 in South Carolina (5)(10). Death certificate and headstone says 1870, but age on the 1880 census was eight. Died September 1, 1957 in Jefferson, Chesterfield Co., SC (7)(10)(61). Buried in the Charlesboro Baptist Church Cemetery, Lancaster Co., SC.

+ Mal?. Listed on the 1900 census. Married about 1897 (22).

+ Docia Watts. Married about 1909 (22). Born 1893 (7). Died 1978 (7). Buried in the Charlesboro Baptist Church Cemetery, Lancaster Co., SC.

a. Theodore T. Barrett. Born August 14, 1913 in Lancaster Co., SC (7)(10). Died February 8, 1924 in Rock Hill, York Co., SC (7)(10). Buried in the Charlesboro Baptist Church Cemetery, Kershaw Co., SC.

a. Marion Barrett. Born November 16, 1902 in South Carolina (7)(30)(51). Died December 13, 1926 (7). Buried in Kershaw City Cemetery, Lancaster Co., SC.

b. Wesley Barrett. Born September 10, 1904 in South Carolina (7)(30)(51). August 7, 1977 (7). Buried in Lancaster Memorial Park, Lancaster Co., SC.

+ Mary Cauthen. Born June 20, 1905 (7). Died November 21, 1986 (7). Buried in Lancaster Memorial Park, Lancaster Co., SC.

c. Hayde Barrett. Born about 1909 in South Carolina (30)(51).

vii. Walter T. Barrett. Born May 7, 1881 according to his headstone (7). Born October 1881 according to the 1900 census (13). Death certificate says May 26, 1880 in Lancaster Co., SC, but he was not listed on the 1880 census in June (10). Died February 8, 1952 in Kershaw Co., SC (10). Headstone says February 7. Buried in the Blackmon Cemetery in Lancaster Co., SC.

+ Almetta Hunter. Born July 14, 1880 (7)(10). Death certificate says 1878 for the year of birth. Died November 1, 1956 in rural Buffalo, Kershaw Co., SC (7)(10). Buried in the Blackmon Cemetery in Lancaster Co., SC.

a. Claude Barrett. Born about 1910 in South Carolina (51).

b. Albenia Barrett. Born about 1902 in South Carolina (51).

c. Cathleen Barrett. Born about 1914 in South Carolina (51).

d. Ravon Barrett. Born about 1915 in South Carolina (51).

e. Gaston Barrett. Born about 1919 in South Carolina (51).

C. Frederick Jasper Barrett. Born January 1, 1816 in Lancaster Co., SC (7)(8). The family knew him as Jasper. F. J. Barrett was listed along with the other Barretts as a customer of the Parker's store in Covington Co., AL. Jasper was living in Stewart Co., TN, in the 1840's as shown by the criminal court case "State vs. Newton Barrett, James P Kendrick, Jasper Barrett" in which Newton and the others were on trial in 1844 for falsifying bills of sale in order to help slaves run away. Newton, James. P. and Sarah Kendrick, Jasper, and Emily Auten are all mentioned (57). Jasper was back in Lancaster County by mid 1848 as he witnessed a Deed for Hiram Joyner then (69). Jasper lived in Lancaster County in 1850, but moved to Union Co., NC, by 1860 and lived the rest of his life there. His obituary stated that he moved from Lancaster to Union 55 years before his death, which would be about 1849. But given that he appears on the census in Lancaster in 1850, the move was more likely 45 years before (possibly a mistake in the obituary), making it about 1859. In 1858, Frederick J. Barrett sold to James Bruce a piece of land around the headwaters of Hanging Rock and Camp Creek that was part of the Joyner estate (70). Given that there were no other Barretts with those initials, this gives us Jasper's full name. In 1860, a Missouri Dease, age 16, is living with Jasper and his wife. It's possible she is related to Evan and Sara Deas mentioned in the 1849 newspaper announcement for Frederick Joyner Jr.'s real estate. Jasper died July 8, 1904 in Union Co., NC (7)(8). Buried in the Barrett Family Cemetery in Union Co., NC.

+ Elizabeth Barnett. Married 1849-1850 (2). Born September 15, 1810 (7). She was the mother of Newton's first wife, Mary Barnett. Her first husband, Bynum Barnett, died in the Mexican War (16). Died March 1896 (7). Buried in the Barrett Family Cemetery in Union Co., NC.

Jasper had no children, but he reared the children of his brother Newton's first family after he died.

D. Emily Barrett. Listed after Barretts as a defendant in the real estate sale announcement from Frederick Joyner Jr. Was living in Stewart Co., TN, in the 1840's as shown by the criminal court case "State vs. Newton Barrett, James P Kendrick, Jasper Barrett" in which Newton and the others were on trial in 1844 for falsifying bills of sale in order to help slaves run away. Newton, James. P. and Sarah Kendrick, Jasper, and Emily Auten are all mentioned (57). Living next door to James and Sarah Hendrick in Montgomery Co., TN, in 1850. Born about 1816-

1820 in South Carolina (2)(3).

+ Paul Auten. Probably married between 1830 and 1840 as Sarah doesn't appear to be living with her mother in 1840. Born about 1787 in North Carolina (2). He is listed as a customer of the Parker's store in Covington Co., AL. Probably died 1855-1860.

i. James Auten. Born about 1839 in Alabama (2).

ii. Sarah J. Auten. Born about 1842 in Georgia (2)(3).

iii. Emiliza *or* Emma Eliza Auten. Born about 1844 in Tennessee (2)(3).

iv. Samuel T. Auten. Born about 1845 in Tennessee (2)(3).

v. Mary Auten. Born about 1851 in Tennessee (3).

vi. Euphrates Auten. Born 1855 in Tennessee (3).

+ William Moore. Born about 1813 in Waterfore, Ireland (3). Tennessee Marriage records have a record for William Moore and Mary E. Orten from August 20, 1860. But this doesn't seem to fit as the census was in July.

E. Newton D. Barrett. Born September 3, 1820 (7)(17). Newton was living in Stewart Co., TN, in the 1840's as shown by the criminal court case "State vs. Newton Barrett, James P Kendrick, Jasper Barrett" in which Newton and the others were on trial in 1844 for falsifying bills of sale in order to help slaves run away. Newton, James. P. and Sarah Kendrick, Jasper, and Emily Auten are all mentioned. Newton appeared to be the main culprit. He was let out on bond put up by Willie/Wiley Barrett, but then after the first part of the trial escaped custody and eluded capture. Rewards were offered but he was not apprehended. The court did not make Willie pay the bond (57)(58). Newton and his family were living in Lancaster County in 1850, but moved to Union Co., NC, by 1860 and was living nearby his brother, F. J. Barrett. He probably married Mary Barnett close to 1850. He was a private in Co. D of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment (Butler's), South Carolina Infantry during the Civil War. Newton died October 6, 1865, a few days after he was shot in an incident with neighbors (7)(15)(17). According to the newspaper, Newton was a "notorious bad character" and he was caught in the act of stealing corn from a widow lady, Mrs. McKain. However, a different version of the story was told by a Mr. Brady Green, a neighbor who remembered the shooting. A group of negroes were suspected of stealing corn from the McKain place. A posse which included Newton was formed to catch the thief. During the night, Newton was accidentally shot. The party agreed that it was Alex Nesbit's shot that had killed him. apparently Sally, wife of John (blank), and Thirza, wife of John W. (blank), filed suit against the executors of Frederick Sr.'s estate.

6. Daniel Joyner. Named as a child in the Lancaster County Returns book for the account of Frederick Jr's estate in 1849. Born about 1779/80 in Lancaster Co., SC, according to later census records (2)(3). However, earlier records put his birth closer to 1790. Daniel appears on the Lancaster County census for 1810, 1820, and 1830. Daniel had an account with a Lancaster County merchant in 1830 where it appears he bought a black fur hat, a vial of laudanum, a coffee mill, sugar, and a vial of paregoric (66). He appears to have either had a first family of his own in Lancaster County before he married Holly, or to have had a family living with him. He was married to Holly by 1835 (25). He had moved to Fairfield County by 1840. A notice appeared in the Lancaster Ledger asking for information on a horse stolen from the Daniel Joyner stables in Fairfield county and to report to Daniel Joyner in Fairfield or to J. M. Joyner in Lancaster (26). This clearly connects Daniel Joyner of Fairfield to the Lancaster County Joyners. Also, the 1850 census states he was born in Lancaster County. In 1860, he was living in Prince William Parish, Beaufort County near his brother William. Deeds from Hampton County show that William conveyed his land to Daniel Joyner, and later Daniel Joyner conveyed the same land to some of his children. Daniel may have had another daughter, Susan (1824-1892) who married Thomas Sims (1824-1911). In a letter sent to Mrs. Floyd and now part of the Viola Caston Floyd Collection, a William James Collins was said to have had two half siblings, Daniel Joyner and Susan Joyner, who married Thomas Sims. This was supposed to be have been noted in a family Bible.

a. Ulysses Layton Joyner. Born July 25, 1869 in Fairfield Co., SC (5)(48). Died January 21, 1918 (48).

+ Fannie Cornelia Johnson. Married December 17, 1891 (48). Born June 17, 1875 or 1876 in Fairfield Co., SC (10)(48). Died June 4, 1947 in West Columbia, Lexington Co., SC (10)(48). Buried in Smallwood, SC (10).

1. F. B. Joyner. Born October 31, 1892 in South Carolina (10). Died October 14, 1918 in Columbia, SC (10). Buried in Smallwood, SC (10).

b. James Addison Joyner. Born January 12, 1871 in Fairfield Co., SC (5)(7)(10)(48). Died January 23, 1943 in Dentsville, SC (7)(10)(48). Buried in Crescent Hill Memorial Gardens and Mausoleum, Richland Co., SC.

+ Mary Maria Collins. Married April 10, 1898 (48). Born March 23, 1877 in Fairfield Co., SC (7)(48). Died January 10, 1961 (7). Buried in Crescent Hill Memorial Gardens and Mausoleum, Richland Co., SC.

c. Herbert Calhoun Joyner. Born about July 17, 1874 near Ridgeway, Fairfield Co., SC (5)(7)(10)(48). Joyner genealogy says 1875 along with headstone, but census shows closer to 1874. Died September 28, 1931 in Dentsville, SC (7)(10)(48). Buried in Sawneys Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Fairfield Co., SC.

+ Rebecca Elizabeth Collins. Born April 21, 1881 in Fairfield Co., SC (7)(48). Died February 21, 1965 (7). Buried in Sawneys Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, Fairfield Co., SC.

d. William Alva Joyner. Born about July 27, 1876 in South Carolina (5)(48). Joyner genealogy says 1873 along with headstone, but the census shows about 1876. Died October 16, 1910 (7)(48). Buried in Johnson-Joyner Cemetery, Richland Co., SC.

+ Tallulah Ophelia Watts. Married February 1898 (48). Born July 2, 1873 in Kershaw Co., SC (10)(48). Died May 10, 1922 in Blythewood, SC (10)(48). Buried in Johnson-Joyner Cemetery,

f. Preston Monroe Joyner. Born December 5, 1881 in Fairfield Co., SC (7)(48). Died March 26, 1910 (7)(48). Buried in Olympia Cemetery, Richland Co., SC.

ii. Amanda Joyner. Name appears as Nancy J. On the 1850 census. Born about 1848 in Fairfield Co., SC (2)(3).

iii. William Hampton Joyner. Born June 1851 in South Carolina (3)(7). Headstone reads either 16, 18, or 19 of June. Died September 13, 1903 in Augusta, GA (7)(48). Buried in West View Cemetery, Richmond Co., GA.

+ Abigail Stevens. Born January 2, 1859 in South Carolina (10). Died March 19, 1931 in Richmond Co., GA (10). Buried in West View Cemetery, Richmond Co., GA (10).

ii. William Dk. Sharpe. Born May 1, 1859 in Hampton Co., SC (3)(5)(10)(13). Died October 21, 1926 in Jesup, GA (10). Buried in Bethlehem Baptist Church Cemetery, Wayne Co., GA. Although William's death certificate states that his mother was Mary Joiner, he appears on the census with Lucy and it states that she is his mother.

+ Sarah E. Anderson. Married about 1890 (13). Born 1873 or 1874 (7)(13). Died January 28, 1957 in Wayne Co., GA (7)(13). Buried in Bethlehem Baptist Church Cemetery, Wayne Co., GA.

a. William Morrison Sharpe. Born January 25, 1891 in Hampton, SC (13). Died August 17, 1968 in Richmond Co., GA (10).

b. Boythe Howell Sharpe. Born August 8, 1892 in South Carolina (7)(13). Died September 11, 1969 (7). Buried in Reidsville City Cemetery, Tattnall Co., GA.

+ Minnie Kennedy. Born October 13, 1889 (7). Died May 12, 1979 (7). Buried in Reidsville City Cemetery, Tattnall Co., GA.

c. Abram Ruth Sharpe. Born April 20, 1894 in South Carolina (13)(49). Died November 11, 1975 in Chatham Co., GA (10). Buried in Forest Lawn Memory Gardens, Chatham Co., GA.

+ Rufus Draughn Brannen. Born November 4, 1894 (7)(10). Died January 19, 1920 in Wayne Co., GA (7)(10). Buried in Bethesda Cemetery, Wayne Co., GA.

+ Harry L. Sease. Born October 25, 1895 (7). Died April 4, 1987 (7). Buried in Jesup City Cemetery, Wayne Co., GA.

D. Daniel Joyner. Born about 1833 in Lancaster Co., SC (2).

E. Frederick Joyner. Born about 1835 in Lancaster Co., SC (2)(3).

F. Elizabeth Martha Joyner. Born about 1838 in Fairfield Co., SC (2)(3). Martha is listed as mulatto on the census. Martha and Mary were probably not children of Holly.

G. Mary A. Joyner. Born about 1838 in Fairfield Co., SC (2)(3). Mary and Elizabeth were twins according to the 1860 census.

7. William Joyner. Named as a child in the Lancaster County Returns book for the account of Frederick Jr's estate in 1849. Born about 1782-1783 in South Carolina (2)(3)(7). Earlier census records put his birth around 1785-90 (1). Was living in Prince William Parish in Beaufort Dist., SC, by 1810. There were two William Joyners in Beaufort District. One of them was a senator in the South Carolina General Assembly 1826-1828 (59). Historians seem to have cited the other William as the senator and in some cases seem to confuse the two. Our William Joyner appears to have always lived in Prince William Parish. The senator is listed from Prince William Parish, whereas the other William Joyner, whom they cite, was from St. Helena Parish. William was living next to Daniel Joyner in 1860 in Beaufort County. He died October 5, 1860 (7). He was buried in the Sandy Run Cemetery, (current) Hampton Co., SC. There is a Mary Joyner Gooding (-1839), Mary Joyner (1832-1918), Hasting G. Joyner (1871-1921), and a



Hasting M. Joyner (1905-1918) in this cemetery as well, but it is unclear at this time if or how they are related to William or Daniel.

+ ?. Appears to have died between 1810 and 1830.

8. John Joyner. Named as a child in the Lancaster County Returns book for the account of Frederick Jr's estate in 1849. John Joyner was a witness on his father's mortgage in 1799 (20). He had two children living in 1849 according to the returns book. Frederick Sr.'s will from 1818 mentions the "legal heirs of my son John Joiner," probably meaning that he had died by then (75). John seems to disappear from the census records and therefore may have died pretty early.

+ Phebe. She is referred to as "daughter-in-law" in Frederick Sr.'s will from 1818 (75). Since John Joiner appears to have died, and the other sons are mentioned, it appears she was John's wife. She was living in Lancaster County in 1820 and 1830 and probably died between 1830 and 1840 (1).

9. Green R. Joyner. Named as a child in the Lancaster County Returns book for the account of Frederick Jr's estate in 1849 and the receipt book record from 1850. Born about 1780-90 (1). Lived in Lancaster County. Died before 1850. Receipt book record states that there were three children. Based on census, probably had a child who died young.

+ Rachel. Named as wife of Green Joyner in a Lancaster District deed (63). Also named in another deed with her husband in the sale of land from the estate of Joseph Coiel (64). It is likely therefore that Rachel was a daughter of Joseph Coiel.

A. Rhoda Summerville. Listed as a daughter of Green Joyner in the receipt book record. She was presumably living in 1855. John M. Joyner had power of attorney from her dated 24 January 1853 to receive the share from the tract of land sold in 1850. She may have been the Rhody Sumerville who married a Mr. Thomas Magouirk in Coosa Co., AL, on August 19, 1853. Both were said to be widowed, and given that the affidavit for power of attorney is dated before the marriage, the fact of her being listed as Summerville in the receipt book in 1855 doesn't pose a problem.

B. John M. Joyner. It is not known for certain whether John M. Joyner was a son of Green Joyner. Living in Lancaster County in 1854 according to an advertisement about Daniel Joyner's missing horses. Also in 1856 based on a notice of a bank note given for J. M. Joyner and Newton D. Barrett (60). There is a John Joyner, born about 1836, living with the J. Clinton family in 1850 in

Lancaster County. This could have been him, but he would only have been about 17 years old when he held power of attorney for Rhoda which seems unlikely.

C. William James Joyner. Born about 1821 in South Carolina (3). Living in Randolph Co., AL, according to the 1850 receipt book record. An affidavit exists from Randolph county records in which Wm. J. Joyner appointed Samuel J. Caston his attorney August 22, 1857. States that his uncle was the deceased Frederick Joyner. W. J. Joyner is listed in the 1860 census in Randolph Co., AL, and on the 1870 census in Hale County.
