Witherspoon* or his successors in office, or assigns, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made and done, we do hereby bind ourselves, and each and every of us, and each and every of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Signed with our hands, and sealed with our seals, this *6<sup>th</sup>* day of *February* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty *six* (1846)

Whereas, the Honorable the Court of *Equity* did on the *27<sup>th</sup>* day of *Decr. 1845* in pursuance of a petition presented to it, by *Jonathan D. Johnson*


appoint the said *Jonathan D. Johnson* Guardian of the person and estate of *Amy E. Reeves* an infant, under twenty-one years of age. *Child of James Reeves (decd)*

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the above bounden *Jonathan D. Johnson* shall decently and according to the degree in life of the said *Amy E. Reeves*

the above named infant, bring up and educate the said infant, and pay over and deliver to the above named infant, when she shall become of age, or be entitled to receive the same, and all the Goods, Chattels, Books, Papers, Writings, sum or sums of money, rights and things and all other the estate and effects of the above named infant, or that she may be entitled to receive; and in case of the death of the above named infant, to pay and deliver over to such person or persons as may, by law, be entitled to the estate of the above named infant, and yearly in every year faithfully account to the said *James H. Witherspoon* or his successors in office or to such person or persons as the said Court may appoint to receive the same, for all the Rights, Books, Papers, Writings, Money, Goods and Effects and all other the Estates of the said infant, which he may have received or be intrusted with as Guardian as aforesaid and shall otherwise well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in him and execute the duties of Guardian agreeable to the laws, usages, and customs of the State aforesaid, then this obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue.




